A virtual / conference call meeting of the Red River Joint Water Resource District (RRJWRD) Full Board was held on June 12, 2024, at 9:30 a.m.

Approval of agenda

A quorum was not met to approve the order of the agenda.

Minutes

A quorum was not met to approve the minutes of the April 10, 2024, meeting.

Financial Reports

The Treasurer discussed the Financial Reports. No action was taken as a quorum was not met.

RRJWRD logo – name tags and apparel

The Board reviewed mockups of name tags and apparel with the new RRJWRD logo. After discussion, the Board requested adjustments to the design and logo used on the name tags and apparel. The Board directed the Secretary to engage the consultant that

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created the logo to revise the logo for use on name tags and apparel and bring it to the next Full Board Meeting for further review and approval.

Baldhill Dam Water Control Plan update

Randy Gjestvang reported on the Baldhill Dam Water Control Plan update stating that the second set of public and agency meetings are complete and a comment period on alternative operating plans ended on June 10, 2024. Mr. Gjestvang reported that a letter was sent from the RRJWRD with comments regarding the proposed updates to the Baldhill Dam Water Control Manual. Brian Fuder stated the Red River Retention Authority also sent a similar letter.

Discussion on strategic watershed planning (land rights)

Discussion was held on strategic watershed planning in regard to land rights needed for water resource district projects. Manager Weston suggested potentially forming a committee to discuss strategic planning regarding land rights for water resource district projects and indicated he will prepare a report regarding the topic for further discussion at the next Full Board meeting. The Board concurred.

Red River Retention Authority (RRRA) Partner Summit

The RRRA Partner Summit will be held on July 31, 2024, in East Grand Forks, Minnesota. Mr. Fuder discussed the agenda for the event and indicated all are welcome to attend. RSVPs for the event will be sent out and will also be available on the RRRA website soon.

Funding for NRCS Watershed Rehabilitation Program

Mr. Fuder reported funding for the NRCS Watershed Rehabilitation Program has decreased to \$1 million nationwide. The Red River Basin currently has 6 projects that qualify for the Program, with estimated costs totaling \$74 million. The RRRA is making a request to North Dakota and Minnesota legislative and congressional delegations to mandate a funding baseline of \$30 million for the Program while retaining the current level of cost-share participation and continue current projects to construction. The RRRA is also requesting the ability to move funds from NRCS programs when and where appropriate. The Board thanked Mr. Fuder and the RRRA for their efforts regarding funding for the NRCS Watershed Rehabilitation Program.

WRDA 2024 bill

Mr. Gjestvang reported on the WRDA 2024 bill. Last fall Senator Cramer's office requested comments from the RRJWRD regarding the WRDA bill. Based off the comments submitted by the RRJWRD, the 2024 WRDA bill includes a funding increase to \$15 million for the Corps of Engineers Section 205 Program.

Legislative Updates

Jack Dwyer and Sean Fredricks reported on legislative updates regarding water resource districts including proposed bills regarding flowage easements, watercourse determinations and stream crossing standards, and discussion on funding and cost-share for water resource district projects.

Manager Thompson joined the meeting at this time.

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Pembina County WRD updates

Manager Kemp welcomed the Board to Pembina County. Manager Kemp and Zach Herrmann updated the Board on Pembina County Water Resource District activities and projects. Mr. Kemp stated there are 10 dams the Pembina County Water Resource District owns and operates, some of which the Water Resource District is working on plans for rehabilitation and improvements with assistance from the NRCS. Discussion was also held on the Bourbanis Dam 2022 disaster event and resulting partial decommissioning project. An optional tour of Bourbanis Dam will be held following the meeting.
