Cost-share request – Pembina County Water Resource District – Investigation for Renwick Dam Safety Improvements

Don Kemp stated that the Pembina County Water Resource District is requesting cost-share for the investigation needed because of a bank failure that occurred on the spillway outlet channel of the Renwick Dam during the week of March 24, 2025. This cost-share request will allow for investigation and analysis needed to develop a recommendation, design, and cost estimate for the repair.

Pembina County Water Resource District is requesting 65% of the non-federal, non-state share of the project to investigate Renwick Dam safety improvements, not to exceed \$19,448. Randy Gjestvang recommended the Executive Committee approve the request.

Brief discussion was held on Natural Resource Conservation Service participation in the project.

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A motion was made by Manager Perdue to approve the Pembina County Water Resource District project to investigate Renwick Dam safety improvements for up to 65% cost-share of the non-federal, non-state share of the project, not to exceed \$19,448. Manager Neset seconded the motion. Upon roll call vote, the motion carried unanimously.
